Main Task: Correct your answers.

*primus iuuenis respondet, 'tu es magnus rex. magni cives post te stant.'
simius est laetus. simius iuuenem dimittit. nunc simius secundum
iuuenem rogat, 'quis sum? qui post me stant?' secundus iuuenis
respondet, 'tu es simius. simii post te stant.'*
