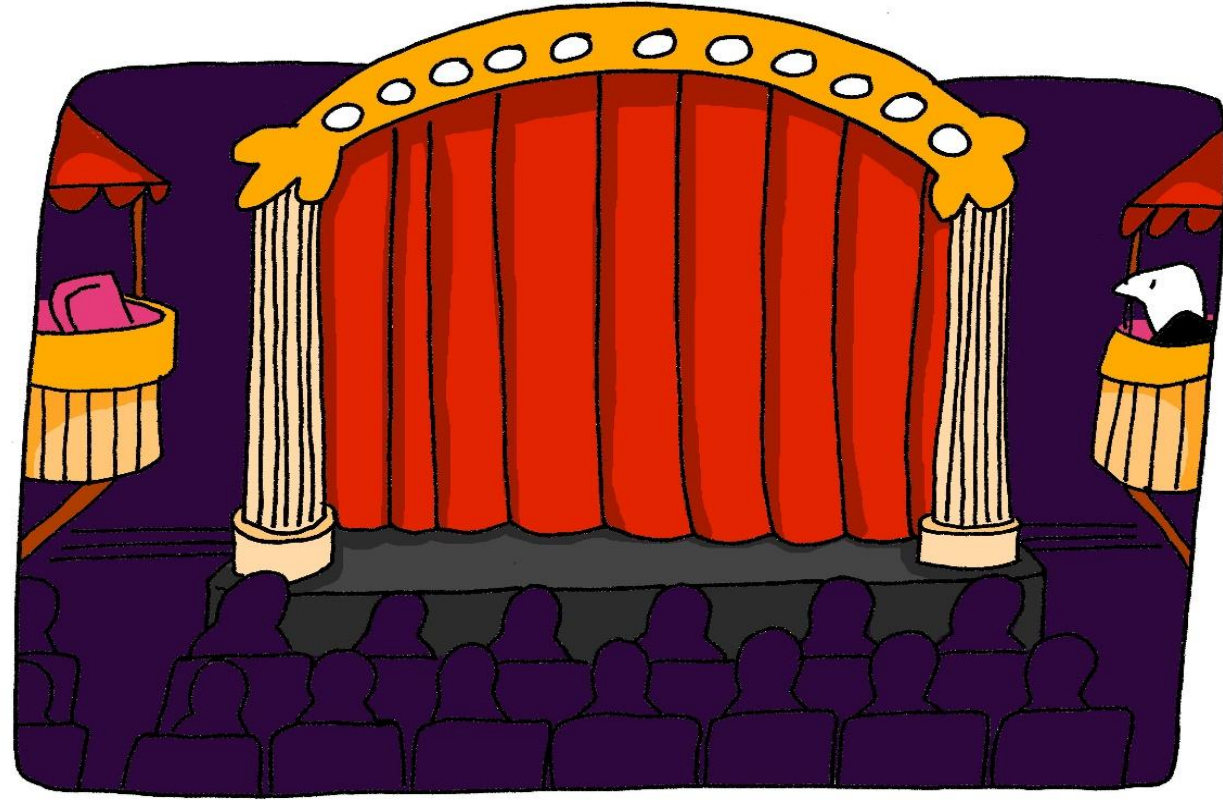

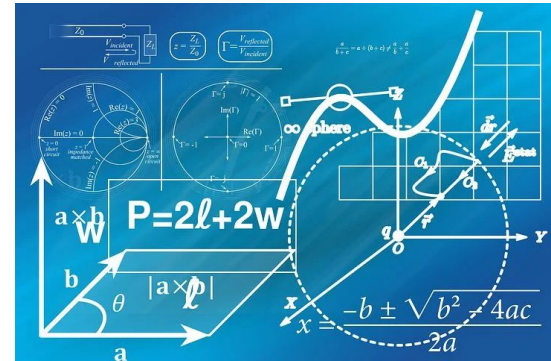

# Grammatik

How to say “I like”



# *mögen* - to like

It's an irregular verb so the conjugations are a bit different.

ich	<b>mag</b>	I like
du	<b>magst</b>	you like
er/sie	<b>mag</b>	he/she likes

How is the *er/sie* conjugation different from normal present tense?

## Coordinating conjunctions



# What is a conjunction?

A conjunction is a word which links two sentences together.

I like Chelsea. I don't like Liverpool.

I like Chelsea **but** I don't like Liverpool.

The word "but" links the sentences together.



# Coordinating conjunctions

The three main coordinating conjunctions in German are:

**und**      and      Ich habe einen Hund **und** er heißt Fin.

**aber**      but      Ich bin sportlich **aber** du bist musikalisch.

**oder**      or      Kommst du mit **oder** bleibst du hier?

After a coordinating conjunction the  
**word order stays the same**



## **denn** - because

*denn* means “because”.

It's easy to use because the word order stays the same.



**denn** is your  
friend

Ich mag Deutsch, **denn** es ist unterhaltsam.

*I like German because it is entertaining.*

You always need a  
**comma** before *denn*



# Introducing coordinating conjunctions.

1. A conjunction **links** two sentences together.
2. The three main coordinating conjunctions are *und*, **aber** and *oder*.
3. *denn* is your **friend** because it doesn't change the word order.
4. Before writing *denn*, you always need to have a **comma** .
5. The word in German for “entertaining” is ***unterhaltsam***
