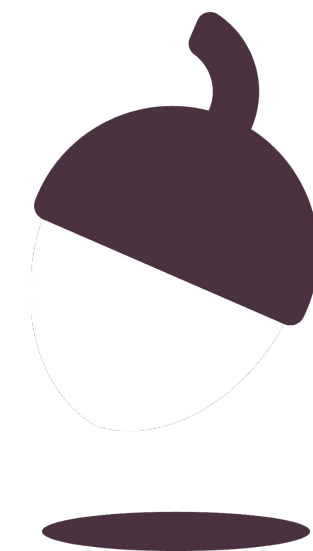

<b>1</b>	compartir	to share, sharing
<b>2</b>	vender	to sell, selling
<b>3</b>	la cosa	thing
<b>4</b>	recibir	to receive, receiving
<b>5</b>	responder	to answer, answering
<b>6</b>	la videollamada	videocall
<b>7</b>	la visita	visit
<b>8</b>	la tarjeta	card
<b>9</b>	la felicitación	greeting



# Present tense -er & -ir verbs: 1st & 3rd person singular

To refer to 'I' with an action **you do now** with -er & -ir verbs, add the verb ending **-o** to the **stem**.

To refer to 'S/he' with an action **you do now** with -er & -ir verbs, add the verb ending **-e** to the **stem**.

**I**

**S/he**

Vend**o** mis cosas viejas.  
*I sell my old things.*

Recib**e** tarjetas de Navidad.  
*She receives Christmas cards.*

<b>Elegir</b> El <u>i</u> go	<b>Salir</b> Sal <u>g</u> o	<b>Ver</b> ve <u>o</u>
---------------------------------	--------------------------------	---------------------------

respond**er** → respond**o** → responde**e**  
compart**ir** → compart**o** → compart**e**



# Present tense -er & -ir verbs: 2nd person singular

S/he

Apren**e** idiomas.

*S/he learns languages.*

Escrib**e** cartas.

*S/he writes letters.*

You (singular)

Le**es** revistas. / ¿Le**es** revistas?

*You read magazines. / Do you read magazines?*

Abre**s** tus correos. / ¿Abre**s** tus correos?

*You open your e-mails. / Do you open your e-mails?*

**The same for both -er & -ir!**

To refer to 'you' singular with **-er & -ir** verbs, add the verb ending **-es** to the **stem**.



# Empareja los números con las letras

5. ¿escribes tarjetas de Navidad?

e) es
