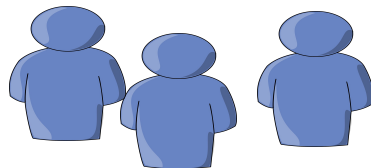
Devoir - have to / must (irregular verb)

Tu dois = You must, have



To refer to one specific person

On doit = You must, have to



To refer to people in general

Use **devoir** with an infinitive to say what someone must do:

Tu **dois faire** de l'exercice = You (specific) must do some exercise.

On **doit faire** de l'exercice = You (general) must do some exercise.



Pour

The word pour has two meanings in French.

Je vais aller **pour** deux semaines

=

I am going to go **for** two weeks

Pour rester en forme...

=

(In order) to stay in shape



Healthy vs unhealthy lifestyles

1. The verb **devoir** means **have to / must**
2. I **must** = **je dois**
3. You (specific) **must** = **tu dois**
4. You (general) **must** = **on doit**
5. The verb **devoir** is followed by the **infinitive**
6. This form of the verb ends in **er, ir, re**
