Early Words

Keep a list of the early words the child **understands**.

Children have to **understand** a word before they can begin using it.

Top tips:

1. Think about things the child **likes** to do and model verbs in those activities



Early Words

2. Use **multisensory** reinforcement to bring the words to life

3. **Repeat!** - Children need to hear new words many times.

When interacting with the child, try to use a new word consistently throughout the activity.

Use it every time you do that same activity.
