Using verbs reflexively in the imperfect tense

Use reflexive verbs in the imperfect tense to describe actions that occurred **continuously** in the past. In the past (imperfect) also use **me** in front of the verb. Use the 'I' endings for the imperfect: **-ar** verbs → stem+ **aba**, **-er/-ir** verbs → stem+ **ía**

I **used to** brush my hair.

Me pein**aba**.

I **used to** get dressed.

Me vest**ía**.



La Nochebuena

1. En el pasado, **celebraba/me celebraba** la Nochebuena en la casa de mis abuelos.
2. Primero, **despertaba/me despertaba** temprano y **duchaba/me duchaba** enseguida.
3. Luego, iba a la iglesia con toda la familia y **rezaba/me rezaba**.
4. Finalmente **comía/me comía** el pavo de mi abuela y **cantaba/me cantaba** villancicos toda la noche.

5. ‘*I used to wake up immediately*’ is: Me despertaba enseguida
