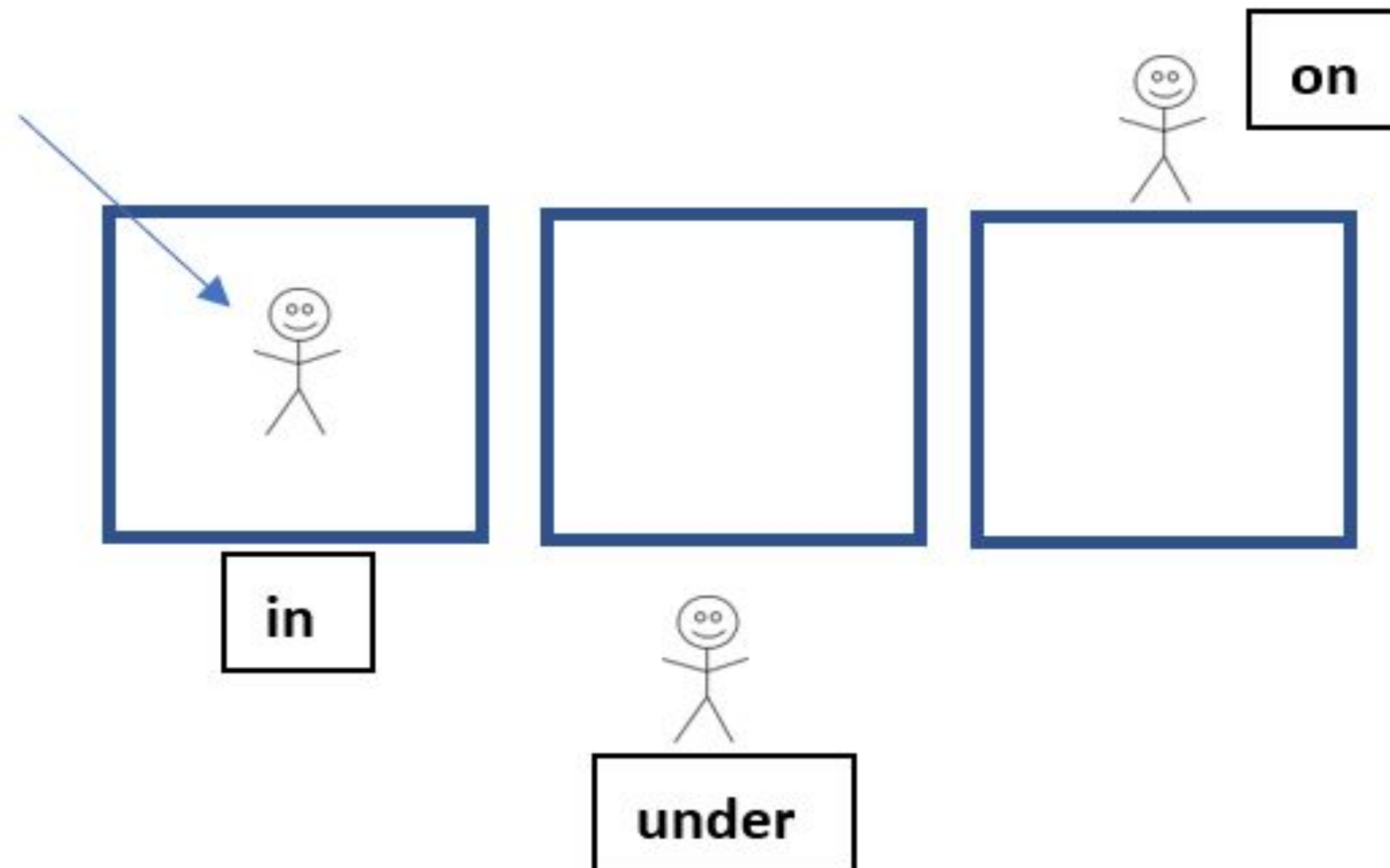

Focus on one preposition at a time. Simplify the task so that an adult models and says the correct sentence, and you copy it exactly.

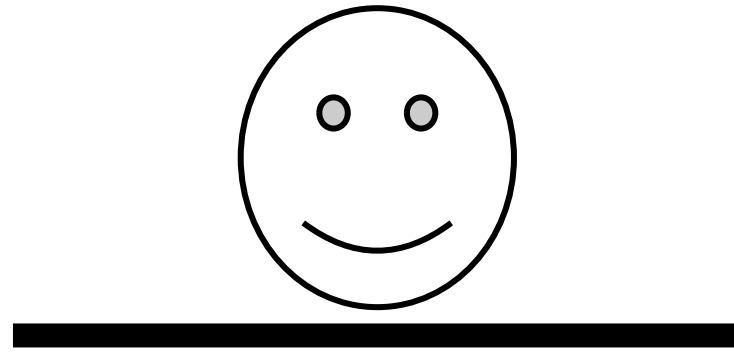
Make it harder

Apply this knowledge to as many contexts as you can. Test yourself when you are shopping, or out on a walk. Do you know any other prepositional language?

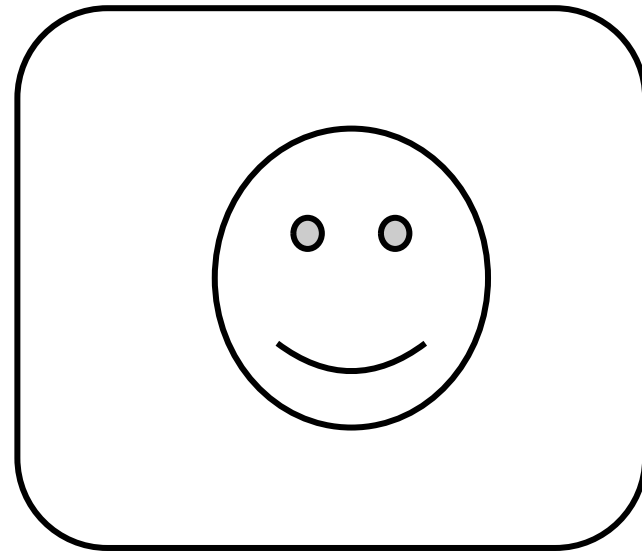
Other ideas

Hide items around the room. A parent or carer may give you clues about where to find it using prepositional language. Then you set them a challenge.

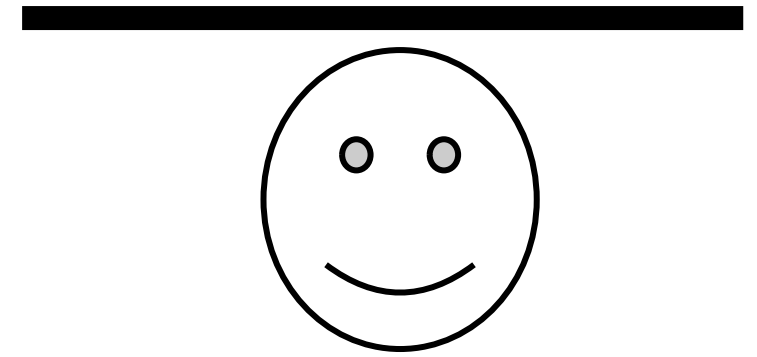
