

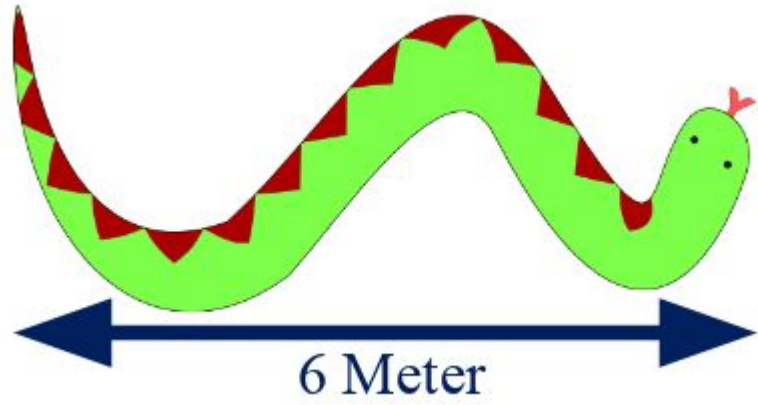

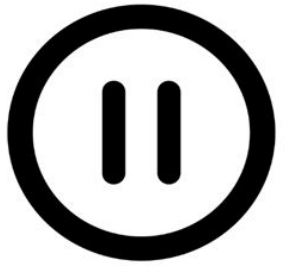

# Demonstrative articles - Summary



Demonstrative articles in German can be translated as “this” or “these”. They follow the same pattern as the definite article (der, die, das).

	<b>m</b>	<b>f</b>	<b>n</b>	<b>pl</b>
<b>nominative</b>	<b>dieser</b>	<b>diese</b>	<b>dieses</b>	<b>diese</b>
<b>accusative</b>	<b>diesen</b>	<b>diese</b>	<b>dieses</b>	<b>diese</b>
<b>dative</b>	<b>diesem</b>	<b>dieser</b>	<b>diesem</b>	<b>diesen</b>
<b>genitive</b>	<b>dieses</b>	<b>dieser</b>	<b>dieses</b>	<b>dieser</b>

Examples in sentences:

1. **Dieser Campingplatz** ist fantastisch. = This campsite is fantastic.
2. **Diese Jugendherberge** ist sehr billig. = This youth hostel is very cheap.
3. **Dieses Gasthaus** ist teuer. = This guest house is expensive.



# Discussing accommodation

1. A demonstrative adjective in German means = **this or these.**
2. I stayed ... = **Ich habe ... übernachtet.**
3. In this youth hostel = **in dieser Jugendherberge**
4. It was old fashioned. = **Es war altmodisch.**
5. There was no wifi. = **Es gab kein WLAN.**
