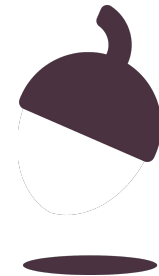

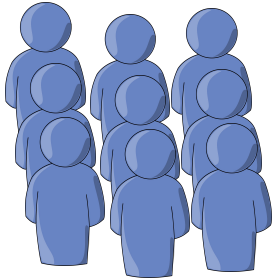


# Pouvoir - to be able to (irregular verb)



People can =

**Les gens peuvent**



To refer to people in general  
**3rd person plural**

Big events can =

**Les grands événements peuvent**



**3rd person plural**

Use **pouvoir** with an infinitive to say what someone or something **can** do



# The advantages of big events

<b>1. Translate: Big events</b>	<b>Les grands événements</b>
<b>2. Translate: On peut</b>	<b>You (general) can</b>
<b>3. Translate: People can</b>	<b>Les gens peuvent</b>
<b>4. Translate: Big events can</b>	<b>Les grands événements peuvent</b>
<b>5. The verb pouvoir is followed by the ..... which ends in .....</b>	<b>Infinitive ER / IR / RE</b>
